Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA)

Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II

Report as of 3/31/2022

- American International College signed and returned the Recipient’s Funding Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students on 04/04/2021. American International College intends to spend at least 50% of the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II (HEERF II) on grants to students.
- American International College has received \$985,439 under the HEERF II student portion.
- As of the reporting date, \$985,439 has been distributed to 671 students.
- American International College determined 804 students are eligible for HEERF II.
- To be eligible for funding, students had to meet the following criteria:
 - AIC received an official 2019-2020 FAFSA or the student completed a 2020-2021 FAFSA by August 1, 2020.
 - Meet Title IV Federal Financial Aid eligibility requirements.
 - Maintaining the minimum requirements of Satisfactory Academic Progress.
- If eligible, students were awarded HEERF II funding based on the following model:

- Funds were distributed directly to students using a paper check.
- Students also had the option to apply all or a portion of their award directly to their bill.
